SERVICES ON COVID-19 IN NAMIBIA.**

1. We announce one thousand three hundred and sixty-four (1 364) new COVID-19 confirmed cases from three thousand one hundred and sixty-six (3 166) results in the last twenty-four (24) hours, which represents 43% positivity ratio. The gender distribution is seven hundred and ninety (790) females and five hundred and seventy - four (574) males. The age range is from four (4) months to ninety-five (95) years. The new COVID-19 cases are geographically distributed as follows:

2. We are reporting cases from thirteen regions, with Khomas region reporting the highest and accounting for 28% followed by Erongo region with 20% of the total number of confirmed cases. Among the confirmed cases are two hundred and nineteen (219) learners, thirty-two (32) students and twenty three (23) teachers from different schools. We are also reporting twenty (20) health care workers.

3. Of all the confirmed cases, thirty - four (34), which represent two point five percent (2.5%) reported to have received one dose of the COVID-19 vaccine, while four (4) of these have been fully vaccinated.
4. We have recorded four hundred and thirty - three (433) new recoveries.

5. We now have twenty-one thousand and fifty-five (21 055) active cases. Five hundred and sixty-one (561) are hospitalized, of which ninety- one (91) are in Intensive Care Units (ICUs).

Windhoek recorded the highest number of deaths totalling 25 of who 3 are home deaths. Engela recorded 3 deaths of who 1 is a home death. Swakopmund-7, Onandjokwe-5, Katima Mulilo-4, Outapi-2 and Opuwo-2. Omuthiya, Tsumeb, Khorixas, Walvis Bay Gobabis and Okahandja recorded one each. Two (2) have received the 1st dose of AZ vaccine.
