**UPDATE BY DR. KALUMBI SHANGULA, MINISTER OF HEALTH AND SOCIAL
SERVICES ON COVID-19 IN NAMIBIA.**

**Check against Delivery*

1. We announce one thousand two hundred and ninety-one (1 291) new COVID-19 confirmed cases from three thousand three hundred and seventy-two (3 372) results in the last twenty-four (24) hours, which represents **38%** positivity ratio. The gender distribution is seven hundred and twenty-eight (728) females and five hundred and sixty-three (563) males. The age range is from twenty-one (21) days to ninety-five (95) years. The new COVID-19 cases are geographically distributed as follows:

2. We are reporting cases from all fourteen (14) regions, with Khomas region reporting the highest and accounting for 32% of the positive cases followed by Otjozondjupa region with 13% of the total number of confirmed cases. Among the confirmed cases are one hundred and fifty- three (153) learners, thirty-seven (37) students and forty-four (44) teachers from different schools. We are also reporting forty (40) health care workers from different health care facilities who have tested positive for Covid-19. Despite the closure of schools, the number of teachers and learners persists to be high.

3. Of all the confirmed cases, twenty- nine (29), which represent two percent (2%) reported to have received one dose of the COVID-19 vaccine, while only one (1) of these has been fully vaccinated.
4. We have recorded four hundred and fifty (450) new recoveries.

5. We now have twenty-one thousand eight hundred and sixty-one (21 861) active cases. Five hundred and sixty- three (563) are hospitalized, of which one hundred and two (102) are in Intensive Care Units (ICUs).

Walvis Bay recorded the highest number of deaths totaling seven (7). Katima Mulilo, Windhoek, Rundu, Swakopmund and Tsumeb reported four (4) deaths each. Onandjokwe reported three (3) and Okahao two (2) while Nankudu, Engela and Omuthiya reported one (1) death each. Among the deaths, 6 deaths were reported to have died at home from Katima Mulilo, Okahao, Nankudu and Engela. None of those whose deaths were reported had been vaccinated.
