1. We announce eighteen **(18)** new COVID-19 confirmed cases from one thousand seven hundred and sixty-two **(1 762)** results in the last twenty-four (24) hours reporting cycle, which represents **1.0%** positivity ratio. The sex distribution is eleven **(11)** males and seven **(7)** females. The age range is from seven **(7)** years to fifty-two **(52)** years. The new COVID-19 cases are geographically distributed as follows:

2. Among the confirmed cases are three (3) learners from different schools, two (2) teachers, one (1) student and one (1) health care worker.
3. One (1) case has received one (1) dose and two (2) cases have received two (2) doses of COVID-19 vaccines.
4. We have recorded one hundred and six (106) new recoveries from five (5) regions:

5. The number of active cases is three hundred and sixty-nine **(369)**. Six **(6)** are hospitalized, and none is in Intensive Care Unit (ICU). None has been vaccinated.

7. By the 3 November 2021, a total of **336 726** people have received one dose of the COVID-19 vaccine, of which **59 108** have received the Janssen & Johnson vaccine, which is only administered as one dose, while **211 533** had received two doses. Therefore, **270 641** have completed the vaccination, as depicted on tables 5 and 6 below:
