**UPDATE BY DR. KALUMBI SHANGULA, MINISTER OF HEALTH AND SOCIAL
SERVICES ON COVID-19 IN NAMIBIA.**

**Check against Delivery*

1. We announce fourteen (**14**) new COVID-19 confirmed cases from one thousand three hundred and fifty-one (**1 351**) results in the last twenty-four (24) hours reporting cycle, which represents **1.0%** positivity ratio. The sex distribution is eight (**8**) females and six (**6**) males. The age range is from six (**6**) years to seventy-two (**72**) years. The new COVID-19 cases are geographically distributed as follows:

2. Among the confirmed cases are four (4) learners from different schools in Tsandi district. One (1) case has received two (2) doses of the COVID-19 vaccine.
3. We have recorded ninety-nine (99) new recoveries from four (4) regions:

4. The number of active cases is two hundred and eighty-three (**283**). Ten (**10**) are hospitalized, and none is in Intensive Care Unit (ICU). One (1) of the hospitalized cases has received two (2) doses of the COVID-19 vaccine.

6. We are reporting one (1) COVID-19 death from Rundu district, a female aged between (30-39) years who died at home on the 4 November 2021, within the 24 hours reporting cycle. The deceased was not vaccinated.
7. By the 4 November 2021, a total of **338 504** people have received one dose of the COVID-19 vaccine, of which **60 222** have received the Janssen & Johnson vaccine, which is only administered as one dose, while **212 500** had received two doses. Therefore, **272 722** have completed the vaccination, as depicted on tables 4 and 5 below:
