SERVICES ON COVID-19 IN NAMIBIA

1. We announce forty (**40**) positive cases from one thousand two hundred and ninety-six (**1 296**) results in the last twenty-four (24) hour reporting cycle, which represents **3.1%** positivity ratio. Out of the total confirmed cases, thirty-eight (38) are new cases and two (2) are reinfections. The sex distribution of the cases is twenty-one (21) females, all new and nineteen (19) males of which seventeen (17) are new. The age range is from two (2) years to seventy (70) years.

2. We are reporting cases from 9 regions, with more cases (12) recorded from Erongo region, constituting 30% of the total cases.
3. Among the confirmed cases are eleven (11) learners, two (2) teachers and one (1) student. One (1) case received one dose of the COVID-19 vaccines, nine (9) cases are fully vaccinated while thirty (30) cases are not vaccinated, accounting for **75%** of the total confirmed cases.
4. One thousand one hundred and fifty-five (**1 155**) cases have recovered.

5. The number of active cases is four thousand eight hundred and seventy-two (4 872). Sixty-three (63) cases are currently hospitalized across thirteen (13) regions, except Kavango West region. Two (2) of the hospitalized cases have received one dose of the COVID-19 vaccine, six (6) are fully vaccinated, while fifty-five (55) are not vaccinated constituting **87.3%** of all hospitalized cases. Three (3) cases are in Intensive Care Unit (ICU). None of the ICU cases is vaccinated.

7. Both deaths occurred on the 6 February 2022 and none of the deceased was vaccinated.

8. By 6 February 2022, a total of **421 693** people aged 18 years and older have received one dose of the COVID-19 vaccine, representing **28.6%** of the target population (1 471 973). A total of **116 434** have received the Johnson & Johnson vaccine, while **245 646** adults have received two doses of other vaccine types. Hence, **362 080** adults have completed their vaccination, translating to **24.6%** of the target population.
9. Five thousand one hundred and eighty-eight (**5 188**) children aged 12-17 years have received one dose of the Pfizer vaccine, representing **1.7%** of the target population (307 298). Of these, one thousand one hundred and sixty-four (**1 164**) are fully vaccinated. Hence, the cumulative number of people vaccinated with the first dose of the COVID-19 vaccine for both adults and children is **426 881** of which **363 244** are fully vaccinated, translating to **20.4%** of the total target population (1 779 271).
10. Eighteen thousand seven hundred and seventy-four (**18 774**) people have received a COVID-19 vaccine booster dose. Details of vaccinations are presented in tables 5, 6, 7, 8 and 9 below.
