**Check against Delivery*

1. We announce sixteen (**16**) new positive cases from two hundred and sixty-five (**265**) results in the last twenty-four (24) hour reporting cycle, representing a **6%** positivity ratio. The sex distribution is eleven (11) females and five (5) males. The age ranges from one (1) year old to seventy-one (71) years.

2. Cases are reported from five (5) regions. Among the confirmed cases, four (4) are learners and one (1) health care worker.
3. Six (6) cases are fully vaccinated of which two (2) have received a booster dose, four (4) cases are not eligible and six (6) cases are not vaccinated.
4. No recovery was reported today.
5. The number of active cases is one hundred and fifty-eight (158). Twenty-nine (29) cases are currently hospitalized in eight (8) regions of which three (3) are in ICU. None of the hospitalized cases is vaccinated.

6. No death was reported for the period under review.

7. By 8 July 2022, a total of **476 996** people aged 18 years and older have received one dose of the COVID-19 vaccine, representing **32.4%** of the target population (1 471 973). A total of **152 643** have received the Johnson & Johnson vaccine, while **266 033** adults have received two doses of other vaccine types. Hence, **418 676** adults have completed their vaccination schedule, translating to **28.4 %** of the target population
8. A total of one hundred and twenty-eight (**128**) individuals have received component one of the Sputnik V vaccine and seventy-six (**76**) have received component two of the same vaccine. Hence, a total of two hundred and four (**204**) doses of Sputnik V were administered. This is included in the grand totals above.
9. Twenty-four thousand three hundred and sixty-six (**24 366**) children aged 12-17 years have received one dose of the Pfizer vaccine, representing **8.0%** of the target population (307 298). Of these, twelve thousand three hundred and sixty-four (**12 364**) are fully vaccinated. Hence, the cumulative number of people vaccinated with the first dose of the COVID-19 vaccine for both adults and children is **501 362** of which **431 040** are fully vaccinated, translating to **24.2%** of the total target population (1 779 271).
10. Seventy- seven thousand six hundred and three (**77 603**) people have received a COVID-19 vaccine booster dose. Details of vaccinations are presented in tables 3, 4, 5, 6, and 7 below.
