SERVICES ON COVID-19 IN NAMIBIA

1. We announce twenty **(20)** positive cases from one thousand three hundred and seventy-eight **(1 378)** results in the last twenty-four (24) hour reporting cycle, representing **1.5%** positivity ratio. The sex distribution of the cases is eleven (11) females and nine (9) males. The age range is from nineteen (19) years to seventy-three (73) years.

2. Among the confirmed cases, three (3) are learners, one (1) is a teacher and one (1) is a health care worker. One (1) case has received one (1) dose of the COVID-19 vaccine, six (6) are fully vaccinated of whom two (2) have received a booster dose. Thirteen (13) cases are not vaccinated.
3. Ten **(10)** cases from three (3) regions have recovered.

4. The number of active cases stands at two hundred and one **(201)**. Twenty-two **(22)** cases are hospitalized in eight (8) regions. Three **(3)** of the hospitalized cases are fully vaccinated, while nineteen **(19)** cases are not vaccinated constituting **74.6%** of those hospitalized. One **(1)** case is in ICU and is not vaccinated.

5. We have not recorded any death during the period under review.

6. By 10 March 2022, a total of **436 815** people aged 18 years and older have received one dose of the COVID-19 vaccine, representing **30.0%** of the target population (1 471 973). A total of **126 916** have received the Johnson & Johnson vaccine, while **250 551** adults have received two doses of other vaccine types. Hence, **377 467** adults have completed their vaccination, translating to **26.0 %** of the target population.
7. A total of one hundred and twenty-eight (**128**) individuals have received component one of Sputnik V vaccine and seventy-six (**76**) have received component two of the same vaccine. Hence, a total of two hundred and four (**204**) doses of Sputnik V were administered.
8. Ten thousand five hundred and forty-five (**10 545**) children aged between 12 and 17 years have received one dose of the Pfizer vaccine, representing **3.4%** of the target population (307 298). Of these, two thousand nine hundred twenty-two (**2 922**) are fully vaccinated. Hence, the cumulative number of persons vaccinated with the first dose of the COVID-19 vaccine (both adults and children) is **447 360** of whom **380 389** are fully vaccinated, translating to **21.4%** of the total target population (1 779 271).
9. Thirty-two thousand five hundred and ninety-four (**32 594**) persons have received a COVID-19 vaccine booster dose. Details of vaccinations are presented in Tables 5 to 9 below.
