**Check against Delivery*

1. We announce five (5) positive cases from sixty-three (63) results in the last twenty-four (24) hour reporting cycle, representing a 7.9% positivity ratio. Of these positive cases, four (4) are new cases and one (1) is a reinfection. The sex distribution is four (4) males of which three (3) are new cases and one (1) female which is a new case. The age ranges from eleven (11) years old to eighty-eight (88) years.

2. Cases are reported from three (3) regions. Among the confirmed cases is one (1) learner.
3. One (1) case is not eligible for vaccination and three (3) cases are not vaccinated.
4. Six (6) cases from two (2) regions have recovered.

5. The number of active cases is one hundred and sixty-one (161). Twenty-six (26) cases are currently hospitalized in seven (7) regions of which three (3) are in ICU. None of the hospitalized cases is vaccinated.

6. No death was reported for the period under review.
7. By 10 July 2022, a total of 477 510 people aged 18 years and older have received one dose of the COVID-19 vaccine, representing 32.4% of the target population (1 471 973). A

total of **153 059** have received the Johnson & Johnson vaccine, while **266 102** adults have received two doses of other vaccine types. Hence, **419 161** adults have completed their vaccination, translating to **28.5 %** of the target population

8. A total of one hundred and twenty-eight (**128**) individuals have received component one of the Sputnik V vaccine and seventy-six (**76**) have received component two of the same vaccine. Hence, a total of two hundred and four (**204**) doses of Sputnik V were administered. This is included in the grand totals above.
9. Twenty-four thousand four hundred and ten (**24 410**) children aged 12-17 years have received one dose of the Pfizer vaccine, representing **8.0%** of the target population (307 298). Of these, twelve thousand three hundred and ninety-six (**12 396**) are fully vaccinated. Hence, the cumulative number of people vaccinated with the first dose of the COVID-19 vaccine for both adults and children is **501 920** of which **431 557** are fully vaccinated, translating to **24.3%** of the total target population (1 779 271).
10. Seventy-seven thousand seven hundred and nine (**77 709**) people have received a COVID-19 vaccine booster dose. Details of vaccinations are presented in tables 4, 5, 6, 7, and 8 below.
