SERVICES ON COVID-19 IN NAMIBIA

14 February 2022

1. We announce thirty-six (**36**) positive cases from one thousand two hundred and sixty (**1 260**) results in the last twenty-four (24) hour reporting cycle, which represents **2.9%** positivity ratio. Out of the total confirmed cases, thirty-three (33) are new cases and three (3) are reinfections. The sex distribution of the cases is twenty-six (26) males of which twenty-five (25) are new cases and ten (10) females of which (8) are new cases. The age range is from six (6) years to seventy-two (72) years.

2. We are reporting cases from 7 regions. Among the confirmed cases are fifteen (15) learners from different schools. Four (4) cases have received one (1) dose of the COVID-19 vaccine and five (5) cases are fully vaccinated while twenty-seven (27) cases are not vaccinated, accounting for **75.0%** of the total confirmed cases.
3. One hundred and fifty-five (**155**) cases from nine (9) regions have recovered.

4. The number of active cases is two thousand seven hundred and eight (**2 708**). Sixty-one (**61**) cases are currently hospitalized across twelve (12) regions. One (**1**) of the hospitalized cases have received one dose of the COVID-19 vaccine, five (**5**) are fully vaccinated, while fifty-five (**55**) are not vaccinated constituting **90.1%** of all hospitalized cases. Five (**5**) cases are in Intensive Care Unit (ICU), of which one (**1**) is fully vaccinated. The remaining four (**4**) are not vaccinated.

- We have not recorded death during the last reporting cycle.
- By 13 February 2022, a total of **426 444** people aged 18 years and older have received one dose of the COVID-19 vaccine, representing **29.0%** of the target population (1 471 973). A total of **119 778** have received the Johnson & Johnson vaccine, while **247 235** adults have received two doses of other vaccine types. Hence, **367 013** adults have completed their vaccination, translating to **25.0%** of the target population.
- Seven thousand eight hundred and eighty-six (**7 886**) children aged 12-17 years have received one dose of the Pfizer vaccine, representing **2.6%** of the target population (307 298). Of these, one thousand four hundred and twenty-one (**1 421**) are fully vaccinated. Hence, the cumulative number of people vaccinated with the first dose of the COVID-19 vaccine for both adults and children is **434 330** of which **368 434** are fully vaccinated, translating to **20.7%** of the total target population (1 779 271).
- Twenty-one thousand five hundred and eighty-six (**21 586**) people have received a COVID-19 vaccine booster dose. Details of vaccinations are presented in tables 4, 5, 6, 7, and 8 below.
