1. We announce sixty-two (**62**) positive cases from one thousand eight hundred and ten (**1 810**) results in the last twenty-four (24) hour reporting cycle, representing **3.4%** positivity ratio. Out of the total confirmed cases, sixty (60) are new cases and two (2) are reinfections. The sex distribution of the cases is thirty-three (33) females of which thirty-two (32) are new and twenty-nine (29) males of which twenty-eight (28) are new. The age range is from twelve (12) months to ninety-nine (99) years

2. We are reporting cases from eight (8) regions. Among the confirmed cases, fifteen (15) are learners of which eleven (11) are from Drimiopsis PS in Gobabis district and the rest are from different schools and (2) students. Six (6) cases are fully vaccinated of which three (3) have received a booster dose, while fifty-six (56) cases are not vaccinated, accounting for **90.3%** of the total confirmed cases.
3. Twenty-eight (**28**) cases from four (4) regions have recovered.

4. The number of active cases is two thousand five hundred and sixty-eight (**2 568**). Twenty-one (**21**) cases are hospitalized. Two (**2**) cases are fully vaccinated, while nineteen (**19**) are not vaccinated constituting **90.5%**. All (**2**) cases in ICU are not vaccinated.

5. By 23 February 2022, a total of **432 299** people aged 18 years and older have received one dose of the COVID-19 vaccine, representing **29.4%** of the target population (1 471 973). A total of **123 901** have received the Johnson & Johnson vaccine, while **249 213** adults have received two doses of other vaccine types. Hence, **373 114** adults have completed their vaccination, translating to **25.3%** of the target population.
6. Nine thousand eight hundred and sixty (**9 860**) children aged 12-17 years have received one dose of the Pfizer vaccine, representing **3.2%** of the adolescent target population (307 298). Of these, two thousand three hundred and seventy-four (**2 374**) are fully vaccinated. Hence, the cumulative number of people vaccinated with the first dose of the COVID-19 vaccine for both adults and children is **442 159** of which **375 488** are fully vaccinated, translating to **21.1%** of the total target population (1 779 271).
7. Twenty-six thousand nine hundred and seventy-one (**26 971**) people have received a booster dose. Details of vaccinations are presented in tables 4, 5, 6, 7, and 8 below.
