1. Good afternoon fellow Namibians. Today, sixteen (16) confirmed COVID-19 cases were identified from nine hundred and eleven (911) results received from the testing laboratories. The gender distribution of the cases is nine (9) females and seven (7) males. The age range is from eight (8) months to sixty-nine (69) years. The new COVID-19 cases are distributed as follows:
