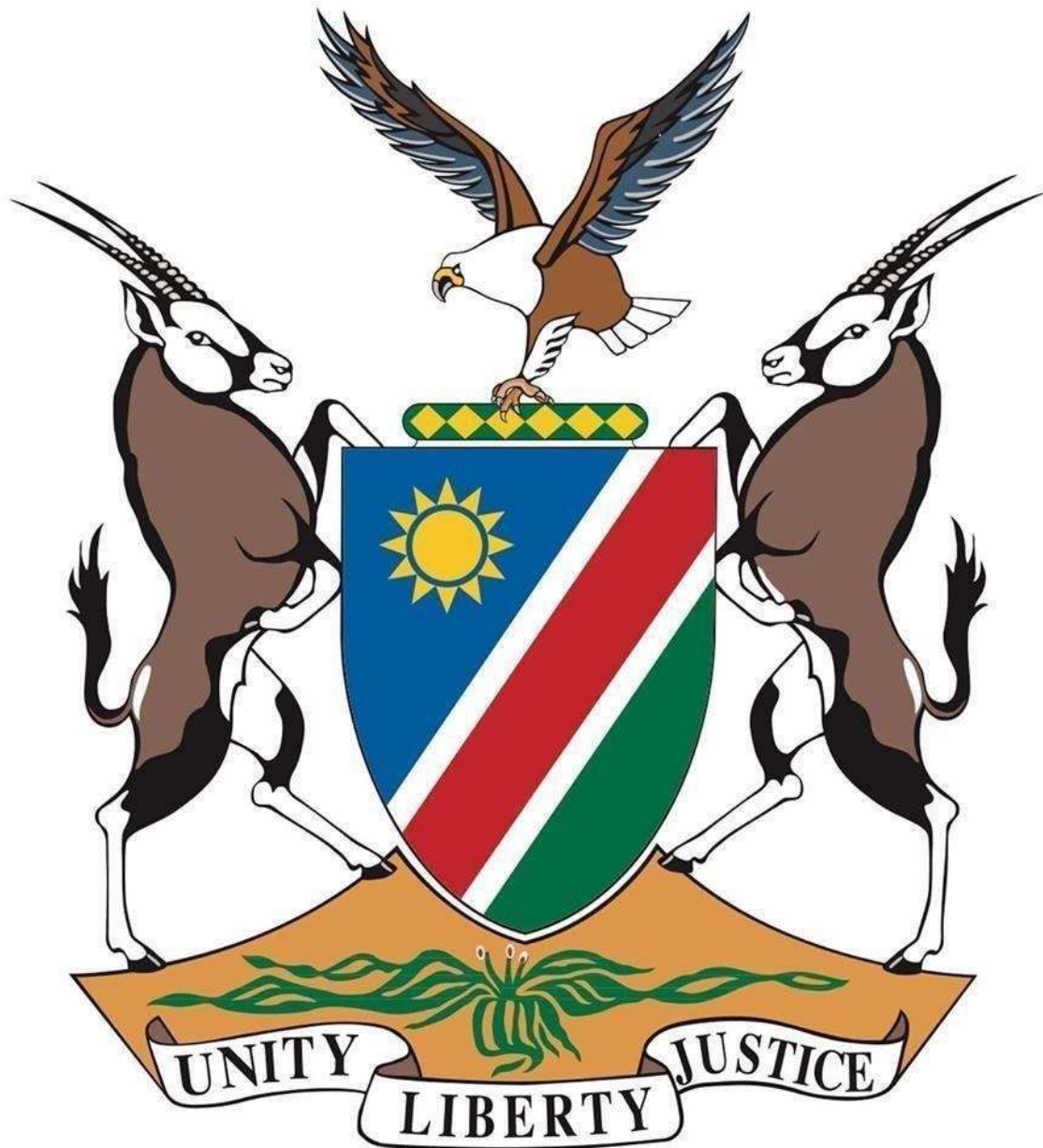

**Check against Delivery*

1. Good afternoon fellow Namibians. Today, fifty-three (53) confirmed COVID-19 cases were identified from seven hundred and fifty eight (758) results received from the testing laboratories. The gender distribution of the cases is thirty-one (31) males and twenty-two (22) females. The age range is from one (1) year to sixty-one (61) years. The new COVID-19 cases are distributed as follows:
