1. Good afternoon fellow Namibians. We have received a total number of 641 results. Thirty-four samples (34) samples tested positive for COVID-19. The gender ratio is nineteen (19) females to fifteen (15) males. Ages range from four (4) days to seventy-six (76) years. The confirmed cases are distributed as follows:
