**Check against Delivery*

1. Good afternoon fellow Namibians. Today, we have received a total number of 724 results. Thirty (30) samples tested positive for COVID-19. The gender ratio is twenty (20) females to ten (10) males. The ages ranges from 4 years to sixty-five (65) years. The confirmed cases are distributed as follows:

2. Today we are reporting 3 new recoveries. Two (2) from Omusati and one (1) from Erongo region. This brings the total recoveries to 10 422.
