Weather Outlook

The Namibia Meteorological Service is hereby distancing itself from reports circulating in the social media regarding a heatwave.

Synoptic Analysis on the 10th of October shows a Cold front that will be moving over Cape Town. A high pressure is ridging behind the cold front and will push the cooler air into South-Africa, causing temperatures to drop gradually from tomorrow. The wind flow will be strong Southerly (25 knots) tonight, becoming fresh South-easterly on Sunday; copies attached.

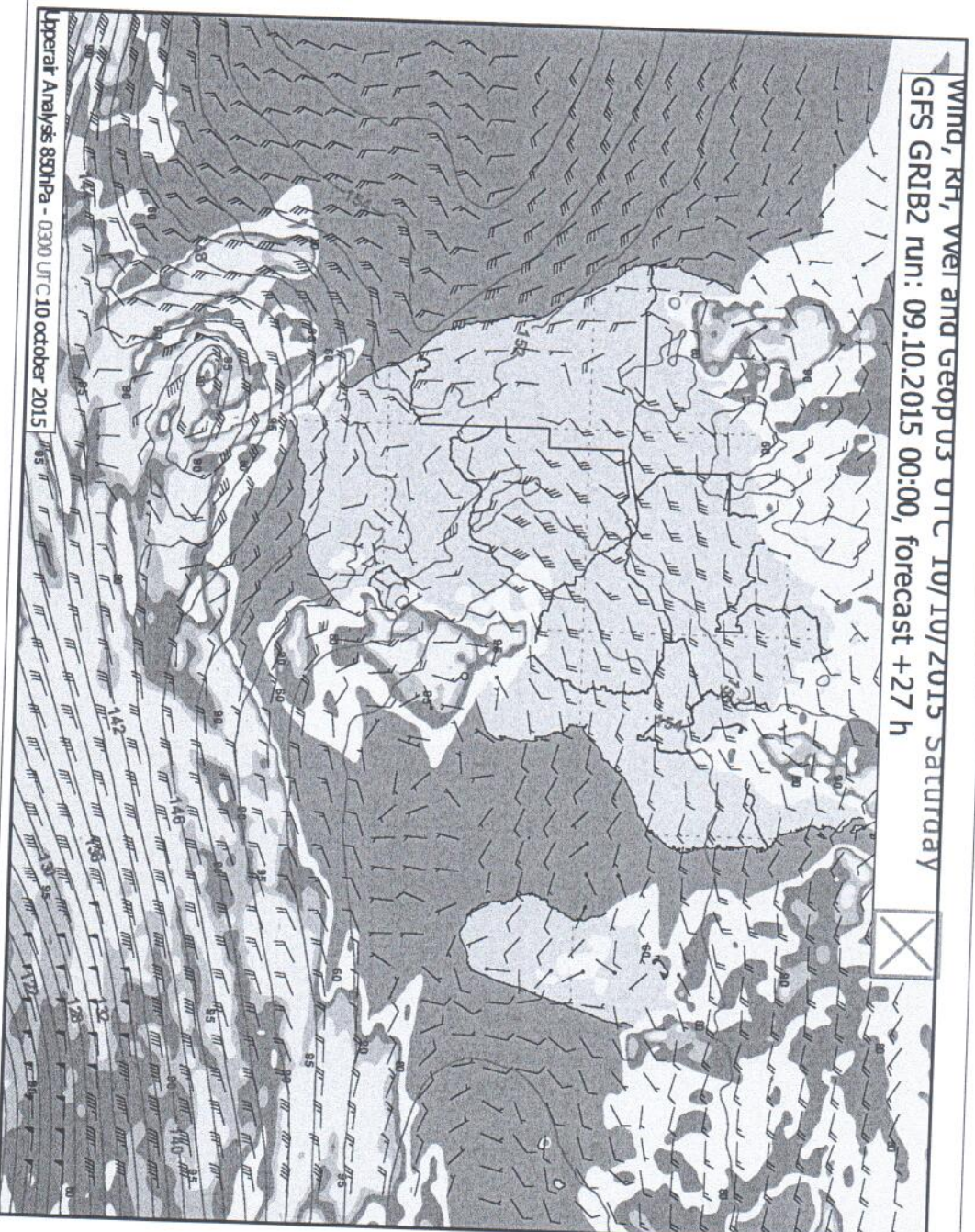


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
