NOTES

- The Selinda Canoe Trail starts and ends at Selinda Airstrip. Should guests only arrive at the Selinda Airstrip on the day that the trail commences, they must arrive by no later than 13h00.
- Unless guests are arriving by private charter, it is essential that they have a night or more in northern Botswana beforehand as guests arriving directly off the Air Botswana flight will not have sufficient time to join the start of this safari. A night at Selinda Camp or Zarafa Camp is recommended before or after.
- Each departure is guaranteed with a minimum of 2 confirmed guests and operates with a maximum of 8 guests, in 4 or 5 tents per safari.
- Please note that the costs of the connecting charters into and out of the safari are not included and are provided by Wilderness Air.
- The canoe trail ends at approximately 10h30, therefore guests will not be able to fly out of Maun Airport before 13h00 on the day of departure

ITINERARY

Day 1-3 - Selinda - Okavango Delta - Botswana

Make sure you eat a hearty breakfast before the adventure begins. The trip kicks off late morning with a game drive transfer from Selinda airstrip, through the Selinda Reserve to the starting point on the Selinda Spillway. Guide your Canadian-style canoe into the water, hop in and set off paddling downstream. Wade through fields of lily pads and the winding channels of the spillway.

The tranquil journey offers you the chance to view a variety of wildlife and bird species. Elephant, buffalo, sable antelope, roan antelope and wild dog are commonly seen along the banks, as well as some 300 bird species.

Overnight at Selinda Riverside Camp (Mobile tented camp) or similar/alternative hotel.

Meals included: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner.

Day 4 - Selinda - Okavango Delta - Botswana

After three days reveling in the mix that lends to this African adventure, travel once more by road to the Selinda airstrip where you can either return home or link this adventure with an additional overland trip.

Overnight at Selinda Riverside Camp (Mobile tented camp) or similar/alternative hotel.

Meals included: Breakfast.
